Training will be provided by Senior Transportation Engineer for all Environmental Engineering aspects of the project. The project also involves sorting all the files and then scanning the reports as PDF files as directed by Environmental Engineering staff on various types of technical reports including, but not limited to, air quality assessment, hot-spot analysis, hazardous waste assessment, site investigations, and noise/vibration impact analysis. All the scanned PDF files need to be placed in the appropriate folders in the network drive. Outcome will involve implementing a fully electronic documentation and data retrieval system for all Environmental Engineering projects. These records include field visit; project plans and scope of work; task orders; technical field procedures; monitoring or laboratory data; and relevant recommendations on environmental engineering issues and concerns in accordance with the state, federal, and local regulations and policies as well as Caltrans internal guidelines and policies. Utilizes various computer software including but not limited to Windows 10 Operating System and Adobe Acrobat.
Prerequisites	Must be a college student attending classes during the regular term (Fall, Spring and Winter, if applicable), at one of the accredited colleges or universities on the UEI affiliation list.
