

## Major L.A. County bus and rail service cuts begin to-

Angelenos will have less frequent bus and rail service starting Sunday, a decision that transit officials have said is temporary to stem a shortage of drivers.

five to 15 minutes, on average, up from every five to 10 minutes, according to the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority. Subway passengers will wait an average of 15 minutes for a train, up from 10; light rail riders will see waits go from eight minutes to 10.

The service cuts come as the transit agency has seen rampant COVID-19 infections among employees and difficulties in hiring and retaining drivers. The plan was a bid to avoid unexpected cancellations of routes that have plagued the region in recent months. ... [Continue here]

## Biden will allow California to set climate limits on cars. The move could influence the rest of the country

The Biden administration is expected to restore California's authority to set its own limits on climate-warming emissions from cars, pickups and SUVs.

Long an environmental leader among states, California often sets precedent that the rest of the country follows. But when it came to combating climate change, the Trump administration hamstrung the Golden State by stripping it of the right to set its own rules around carbon pollution for the thousands of cars cramming the state's freeways.

Now, the Biden administration is preparing to undo that Trumpera decision. And the reversal will resonate beyond California to the whole nation's transportation sector. Federal officials are preparing to restore a "waiver" to regulators in California, giving them the ability to set standards tougher than those from the federal government for the carbon dioxide that spews out of automobile tailpipes, according to two people familiar with the decision who spoke on the condition of anonymity ahead of the Visit our WEBSITE for the latest job posts, newsletters, and agency's announcement. 
