Gas-tax increase to pay for road repair clears California Legislature [CLICK HERE]

The state Legislature on Thursday passed a sweeping \$52 billion transportation plan that will raise California gas taxes after leaders struck deals with wavering lawmakers to fund road projects in their districts. The legislation will raise the money to pay for the plan over 10 years. It raises the base gasoline excise tax by 12 cents, creates a transportation improvement fee based on the value of a vehicle (vehicle registration fees), raises diesel excise and sales taxes.

The \$1 fee you pay covers freeway call boxes and other stuff in Orange County [CLICK HERE]

In 2006, there were nearly 1,300 call boxes along Orange County freeways and toll roads. Now, there are but 414.....The thinning out is for good reason.....the victim of cell phones. In 2005, there were 15,600 calls made from them in the county, and just 1,717 a decade later.


