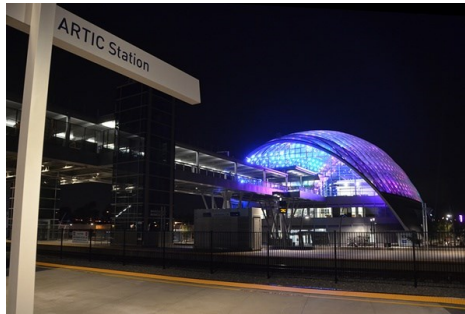


March Presentation:
